Interdisciplinary Biomedical Sciences Program Scholarship Application Guidelines for International Students

Revision approved on December 7, 2016

1. Objective: To enhance the competitiveness and widen the international perspective for our students, a scholarship is established to encourage outstanding foreign students to apply this Program.
2. Applicants: For undergraduate students enrolled in the Fall semester of each academic year.
3. The source of this scholarship is made available by public foundations, private corporations and individual donations.
4. Validity: The duration of scholarship award for each student may not exceed four years over the course of study in this Program. In the occurrence of events such as student's change of major, being suspended/expelled from this Program the scholarship will be terminated right away.
5. Eligibility: Students who are officially accepted by the Program and have completed the enrollment procedure verified by the International Student Admissions Committee.
6. Scholarship Amount and Regulations :
 - (1)Up to NT\$120,000 per person per semester.
 - (2)From the second semester on, A Scholarship Review Committee will determine the eligibility of each recipient based on the overall academic performance in every semester.
7. Application Date:

Follow the guideline of official academic calendar for each year.
8. Submitted Documents:
 - (1)Freshmen: Scholarship application form, previous school's academic records and official documents, photocopy of post office account, and the semester selection course list.
 - (2)Existing students: Scholarship application form, academic records from the previous semester, and the semester selection course list.
9. Other rules unspecified in this act should be governed by the school-related laws and regulations.
10. This Scholarship Guideline, and its revisions or cancellation, shall be approved through departmental meeting and school supervisory bodies.
